and GEORGE JAMES BETTS of 28 High Street Stony Stratford aforesaid Builder
SEND GREETING this 28th day of September One thousand nine hundred and
thirty seven

W H E R E A S by a Conveyance of even date with and executed immediately
before this Deed a certain piece or parcel of land situate in the Parish of
Wolverton Saint Mary Stony Stratford aforesaid containing by admeasurement one
acre or thereabouts as the same was with the boundaries abuttals and dimensions
thereof delineated in the plan annexed thereto and therein coloured blue was
conveyed to the said The Reverend Eric Arnold Steer and his successors and the
said Douglas William Anderson Bull and George James Betts in fee simple subject
to the covenant therein mentioned but upon the trusts and with and subject to
the powers and provisions contained in a Declaration of Trust therein referred
to being this Deed A N D W H E R E A S certain buildings have recently been
erected on the said land and part of the cost of erecting the same has been
provided out of the proceeds of sale of Saint Mary's School belonging to the
said Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary and part has been provided out of the
proceeds of sale of Saint Giles' School belonging to the said Parish of Saint
Giles and formerly subject to the trusts of the Rose and Crown Charity
established at Stony Stratford aforesaid under the Will dated the 1st day of
June One thousand six hundred and ten of Michael Hipwell A N D W H E R E A S
the said The Reverend Eric Arnold Steer as the present incumbent of the said
Parish of Saint Giles and the said Douglas William Anderson Bull and George
James Betts as the present Churchwardens of the said Parish of Saint Giles are
respectively the Trustees for the administration or management of the said

Rose and Crown Charity

N O W THIS DEED W I T N E S S E T H AND IT IS HEREBY
DECLARED as follows :-

1. IN this Deed and in the Schedules hereto the following expressions shall where the context so admits have the following meanings respectively that is to say :-

(A) "The Parish of Saint Giles" means and includes the ecclesiastical parish or district of Saint Giles Stony Stratford in the County of Buckingham containing the former ecclesiastical parishes or districts of Saint Giles and Saint Mary Magdalene Stony Stratford aforesaid

(B) "The Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary" means and includes the ecclesiastical parish or district of Wolverton Saint Mary Stone Stratford aforesaid

(C) "The said premises" means and includes the said piece or parcel of land conveyed by the said Conveyance of even date herewith

(D) "The Vicar of Saint Giles" means and includes the said Reverend Eric Arnold Steer or other incumbent for the time being of the Parish of Saint Giles

(E) "The Vicar of Wolverton Saint Mary" means and includes the Reverend Edward John Payne or other the incumbent for the time being of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary

(F) "The National Society" means the incorporated National Society for Promoting Religious Education in accordance with the Principles of the Church of England

(G) "The Trustees" means and includes the said The Reverend Eric Arnold Steer and his successors to the incumbency to the Parish of Saint Giles Stony Stratford aforesaid and the said Douglas William Anderson Bull and George James Betts or other the person or persons or corporation in whom the said premises

are for the time being vested under this Deed

2. THE Trustees hold and shall hold the said premises UPON TRUST to permit the same and all or any buildings or building which now are or may hereafter be erected thereon or on any part thereof to be used from time to time by the Vicar of Saint Giles or during his absence or disability or the avoidance of his Benefice by the Principal Officiating Minister for the time being of the Parish of Saint Giles or by the Vicar of Wolverton Saint Mary or during his absence or disability or the avoidance of his Benefice by the Principal Officiating Minister for the time being of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary or by the Nominees or Licencees of any of them for all or any of the purposes following that is to say :-

(A) As a school for the Education of Children and Adults or children only of poor persons in the Parish of Saint Giles and the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary and in such other Parishes in respect of which there may for the time being be in force an arrangement under the Education Act 1921 Section 33 or otherwise for grouping the Schools in such Parishes respectively with the said School.

(B) As a Residence or Residences for a Teacher or Teachers of the said School

(C) As a Class-Room Meeting Room or Lecture Room for Confirmation or Communicants' classes or for other Religious Instruction or for Secular Instruction

3. SUBJECT and without prejudice to the trusts hereinbefore declared the Vicar of Saint Giles or the Vicar of Wolverton Saint Mary or such Principal Officiating Minister as aforesaid may with the consent of a Committee to be called the Administrative Committee and to be constituted as set out in the First Schedule hereto permit the said premises or any part thereof (at hours when the same shall not be actually in use for any of the purposes hereinbefore

defined) to be used for the benefit equally of the Parish of Saint Giles and the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary and such other Parishes in respect of which there may for the time being be in force an arrangement under the Education Act 1921 or otherwise as aforesaid as a place of meeting for Clerical Meetings for Social Conferences of the Clergy for District Visitors for Committees of any Societies for the promotion of any Religious Philanthropic Charitable or Benevolent Purpose and for Meetings to be called in aid or for the benefit of any such Societies or for any other Meetings or for any other objects ends or purposes having in view the spiritual intellectual moral or social wants of the neighbouring population which the Vicar of Saint Giles or the Vicar of Wolverton Saint Mary or such Principal Officiating Minister as aforesaid as the case may be with such consent as aforesaid may think proper BUT this provision is permissive only and is not intended to be construed or considered as forming any part of the trusts of this Deed which are for the ecclesiastical religious and educational purposes hereinbefore defined exclusively

4. PROVIDED ALWAYS AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER DECLARED that the said premises shall not nor shall any part thereof be used for any purpose whatsoever which may be inimical to the welfare or contrary to the principles of the Church of England as now by Law established and the said School shall always be in union with and conducted according to the principles and in furtherance of the ends and designs of the National Society

5. SUBJECT to the trusts hereinbefore declared and the provisions and declarations herein contained the said premises while used for the purpose of a School shall be managed and controlled by a body of Managers appointed and constituted as set out in the Second Schedule hereto

6. PROVIDED ALWAYS AND IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the Trustees may at any time hereafter and from time to time so often as the Trustees with the consent hereinafter required shall think fit by any deed or deeds to be executed by the

Trustees with the consent of the National Society to be testified by their concurrence in such deed or deeds or by some other writing or writings under their Common Seal but not otherwise revoke the trusts hereinbefore declared or any of them as to either the whole or any part or parts of the said premises and declare (either irrevocably or subject to a similar power of revocation and declaration of new or other trusts) such new or other trusts of or as to the said premises or any parts thereof for the purposes of the education of poor persons in religious and useful knowledge as the Trustees may with such consent as aforesaid determine BUT so that such purposes shall benefit as equally as may be the Parish of Saint Giles and the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary and that children of parents who are members of the Church of England shall if possible be provided for PROVIDED that the consent of the National Society shall only be necessary in the case of the said premises being then used as such School or Residence as aforesaid and a grant of money being made by the National Society in respect thereof and not repaid

7. PROVIDED ALSO that if at any time hereafter the said premises or any part thereof (whether then used as a School or as a Residence as aforesaid or for any other education purposes) shall cease to be used for purposes which are in union and accordance with the principles and in furtherance of the ends and designs of the National Society the trusts hereinbefore declared or the trusts then subsisting in respect of the said premises shall thereupon immediately cease and be revoked as to the whole or the part or parts of the said premises which shall have ceased to be so used as aforesaid (as the case shall require) and the said premises or such part or parts thereof as aforesaid shall thenceforth be held upon trust for some other purposes of the education of poor persons in religious and useful knowledge such other purposes to be in union and accordance with the principles and in furtherance of the ends and

designs of the National Society and to be determined or defined by the Trustees by some deed or lease to be executed by them with the consent of the National Society to be satisfied as aforesaid and in default of any agreement or defining such trusts being so made between the Trustees and the National Society within one year after the said premises or such part or parts thereof as aforesaid shall have ceased to be so used as aforesaid then by a Scheme to be made under the jurisdiction of the Board of Education or the High Court of Justice

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE

1. The Administrative Committee shall consist of the Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Saint Giles and the Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary and the four persons who are for the time being Foundation Managers of the said School as representatives of the Parish of Saint Giles and the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary respectively.
2. The First Meeting of the said Committee shall be convened by the Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Saint Giles and at such meeting a Secretary and such other officers as the Committee shall think fit shall be elected.
3. The Chairman for the time being of the Managers of the said School shall be the Chairman of the Administrative Committee

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

MANAGERS

The Managers shall be appointed from time to time in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the National Society. PROVIDED ALWAYS that the said Managers in the first instance shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the Education Act 1921 Section 30 (5) (c) that is to say as Foundation Managers :-

- (A) The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Saint Giles
- (B) The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary
- (C) The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Wolverton
- (D) Two Representatives of the Parish of Saint Giles appointed from among persons whose names are for the time being of the Electoral Roll of the Parish of Saint Giles
- (E) Two Representatives of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary appointed from among persons whose names are for the time being on the Electoral Roll of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary
- (F) One Representative of the Church School Managers of Whaddon and Rush

The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Saint Giles and the Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Wolverton Saint Mary shall act as Chairmen of the Managers in turn each Minister serving for a period of three years and the Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Saint Giles shall be the first Chairman and his period of service shall date from the 1st of January 1937. In the event of the absence or disability or the avoidance of the Benefice of the Principal Officiating Minister who is for the time being Chairman of the Managers his office as Chairman shall for the time being be taken by the Principal Officiating Minister of the other Parish as the case may be and in the event of the

simultaneous absence or disability or the avoidance of the Benefices of
both Parishes then the Managers shall elect their own Chairman for the
time being
