

The Iron Age people of Britain, known as the Celts, were fearsome warriors. Use the internet and information books to find out about Celtic warriors. Use your existing knowledge and research to draw a detailed illustration of a Celtic warrior and write a short paragraph to describe their beliefs, clothing, weapons and warfare.



Research information to help you construct a timeline of Milton Keynes. This could include events such as Bletchley Park (WW2) Development of new city City status Opening of shopping centre You could go back as far as the Romans (Stony Stratford High Street and Bradwell Abbey) What new information can you share?

What forces are there in a playground.? Create a model or poster of your own playground design.



Label the forces and explain how they allow things to move, speed up, slow down and stop.

Find out about a settlement from the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age. What type of buildings did they have? What were they built out of? What did a settlement look like? Make notes and draw sketches to help you design your own model of one of these settlements. Think about what materials you can use to make your settlement look realistic.

Create a fact file about a UK city. You could choose somewhere you have visited or somewhere you would like to visit. Can you find unusual facts about it. You should include maps, pictures and facts.

Fabric dyeing—find out about the different materials people in the Stone Age used to colour fabric. Use a piece of unwanted cotton or string to experiment with natural dyes like berries, vegetables and plants. What colours can you create? Can you make a miniature piece of clothing or weave using the string?



The Grand Union Canal goes through Milton Keynes. Barges are known for their colourful decoration. Create a fact file about narrow boats, including illustration and information about what barges were and are used for.



Create a poster encouraging people to visit Stony Stratford. Why should people visit? What annual events are there? What can they do? Where can they stay? Where can they eat? Remember to use persuasive language.
