<u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will continue to look at comparing size, mass and exploring patterns. We will also continue to subitise 1, 2, 3 . We will look different arrangements of numbers , spotting smaller numbers in bigger numbers.

<u>English</u>

In English this half term we will begin to hear initial sounds in words and practice writing these sounds. We will begin to write CVC words and even adding words into sentences.

<u>RE</u>

Our key question in RE this half term will be about Christmas. We will explore the question What is Christmas?

<u>PSHE</u>

Our Jigsaw unit this half term will be celebrating differences. We will look at how we are special, and how our families and homes are different.
