MFL

In our French lessons, we will be focusing on learning colours and shapes.

Music

Our unit this half term focuses on singing techniques.

English

In English we will be starting our writing based on 'Stone Age Boy' We will be teaching the children how to write a range of sentences in paragraphs and how to edit their own work. Daily SPaG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) will work alongside Spelling Shed homework. We will be looking at various spelling patterns and elements of grammar and punctuation.

Reading comprehension is taught through a series of .'Book Talk', 'Echo reading', Modelled and Independent Comprehension'.

Year Three Autumn Term 2 2023

Maths

Children will continue to use Times Tables Rock Stars to help improve their knowledge of times tables.

We have moved onto addition and subtraction and have been learning how to use column methods to calculate answers.

The first multiplication and division unit looks at developing mental methods to calculate multiples and how these relate to division.

RE AND PSHE

We will be asking the 'Big Question', Is light a good symbol for celebration?



Our PSHE lessons will revolve around 'celebrating differences'. We will be exploring how we learn to cope with and resolve conflict within families and with our friends.

History Through the Ages

We will be continuing our journey form the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

We will consider questions such as:
How have homes and settlements changed throughout prehistory?

Discovery

Art and Design Prehistoric Pots

We go back to the Bronze Age for this project. The children will be exploring different clay techniques, which they use to make and decorate a Bell Beaker-style pot.

Design Technology Cook Well, Eat Well

This project teaches children about food groups and the Eat Well guide. The children choose and make a taco filling according to specific design criteria.



Science Animal nutrition and the Skeletal System

This project teaches children about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. They will learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton.

Computing

In Computing we will be learning how to use features of Microsoft PowerPoint to make a presentation about ourselves adding voiceover and images to engage and interest our audience.
