

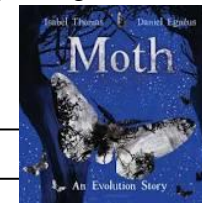
Maths

We will be looking at Fractions, we will begin with looking at equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, adding and subtracting mixed numbers, multiplying and dividing fractions by integers and by fractions. We will then be looking at converting units, starting with converting metric measures moving onto converting imperial measures.



English

For our Write Stuff units we will be writing a persuasive speech using a book about Greta Thunberg as our inspiration. Following this we will be writing a poem using the book 'Moth' as our inspiration. Spellings will continue to be sent out weekly via spelling shed. If children are unable to access spelling shed, then a paper copy is available from their class teacher.



RE

This half term we continuing to learn about Christianity. Our big question is 'Is 'God Made Man' a Good Way to Understand the Christmas Story.' We begin by looking at the Christmas story in two of the Gospels from the Bible. We will explore what Christians are actually celebrating at Christmas. We consider what incarnation means and linking it to Hindu religion.



Computing

This term we will be looking at the computing unit 'We are Connected' which looks at developing skills for social media



Science

We will be continuing with our topic of 'Evolution and Inheritance.' We will continue to look at living things and how they have changed over time, we will look at what fossils are and how they are made. We will then move onto the topic of Electricity. We began by looking at the symbols used in a series circuit, and we then investigated what would happen to those circuits if we added more lamps or batteries.

Homework

PE for 6A will be on a Monday and Thursday, for 6B it will be on a Thursday and Friday and 6C it will be on a Tuesday and Thursday.



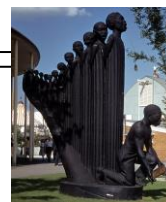
History

Our topic for this half term is called 'Maafa', we will be looking at Britain's involvement in the slave trade, looking at the causes and consequences of the slave trade. We will also look at the impact on the lives of slaves.



Art

Our topic for this half term is called 'Trail Blazers Barrier Breakers', we will be looking at significant black artists and their work, we will then use their work as inspiration to create our own.

We will be looking at 'Celebrating Difference.' We will look at the perceptions of normality, understanding disability and bullying. We will also look at inclusion and exclusion, the differences as conflict and difference as celebration.
