Write a report about the importance of seasonal eating to the environment. Using local produce helps to reduce the number of food miles. Go to the supermarket with an adult and look at the packaging labels. Make a list of which foods are grown locally and which are imported from abroad. Research which foods had to travel furthest to get to the supermarket.





Find out more about ,'Fair Trade.' How does it help farmers in poorer countries to get a better price for their produce. Create a poster to encourage shoppers to buy fair trade goods.

Afterwards, use the BBC Good Food website to find a recipe for a seasonal meal. Write a shopping list, then prepare the meal with an adult.
