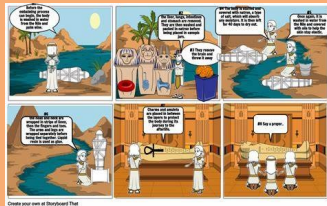
Music

English

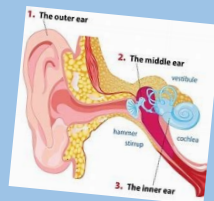
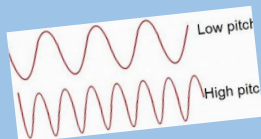
Take a piece of A4 paper and split this up into 8 squares. In each square draw a cartoon sketch about daily life in ancient Egypt.



Science

In Science we are learning all about sound.

Investigate 'how sound is made'. Draw or make a diagram of an ear with a description for each part of the ear. Create an explanation text showing how we hear things to accompany your diagram or drawing.



Art

Design an ancient Egyptian death mask using clay, junk modelling, paper mâché or another material of your choosing. Think carefully about your design and how you will make the mask 3D.

Alternatively, you could create a cat mask as Egyptians were known for their love of cats. Consider the decoration carefully and how you will make it 3d in the design phase.

Maths

Draw an exciting and interesting map of a pharaoh's tomb. Consider what would be inside the tomb when creating the map. Write a set of instructions on how to safely get through, avoiding any traps! Think about using directional language such as left, right, forwards, backwards, right angle turn, quarter turn, half turn, 360 degree turn.

How you present your map is up to you! However, it should be bright, interesting and show that you have taken some time to create it.

Science

Complete a sound survey by taking a walk indoors or outside. Identify the sounds that you can hear. What is making each sound? Is the pitch low or high? Is the volume quiet or loud?

How did these sounds reach your ears? Choose one of the sounds you heard and write about how that sound travelled from its source to your ear.



English

Research the uncovering of Tutankhamun's tomb and use this information to write a newspaper article about the discovery. Remember to include the 5 W's and the how - what has happened, who discovered it, where was it discovered, when was it discovered, how was it uncovered.



DI

Find and make some ancient Egyptian recipes.

Write a menu for an ancient Egyptian feast. Be as creative as you like. Compare food from ancient Egyptian times to today's food.
