ART

In art the children learn about the visual qualities of line, light and shadow. They explore the work of Pablo Picasso and Rembrandt and are introduced to a range of shading techniques. The unit culminates in the children producing a still life painting of natural objects.

MATHS


Our 'White Rose' scheme concentrates on two main areas this half term: area and perimeter and statistics (line graphs, tables and charts). COMPUTING

In this unit 'We are game developers,' children learn how to create a computer program for a computer game using sequence, selection, repetition and variables. They also learn how to debug their games.

SCIENCE

This project teaches children about animal life cycles, including the human life cycle. They explore human growth and development to old age, including the changes experienced during puberty and human reproduction.



PE/GAMES

As usual our sport specialists will be delivering an exciting programme of P.E and games lessons which will enable the children to learn a wide range of new skills.

PSHE

In PHSE we will be continuing to follow the Jigsaw scheme of work. Through our topic this half term we will be considering 'Healthy me,' and looking at how we can live a healthier lifestyle.



FRENCH

Our French unit this half term is called, 'The French-speaking World.' The children will discover the many French-speaking countries, giving and following directions in French and discussing climate using comparative language.

MUSIC

In music the children will be exploring the associations between music, sounds and colour; composing and performing their own musical composition to represent Holi, the Hindu festival of colour that celebrates the beginning of spring and the triumph over good and evil.
