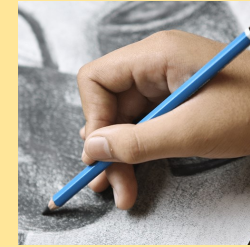
Find out why Pablo Picasso is one of the most famous artists of recent times. Write a biography about his life and work and prepare it as a presentation that could be shared with the class.



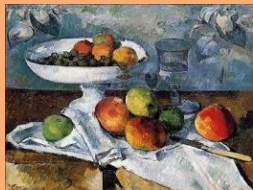
Write a letter to the Minister for Education to persuade them to encourage schools to buy sports equipment from fair trade companies, that do not use child labour. Remember some of the key features we have used when writing a similar letter in our writing lessons based on the book 'Kick' by Mitch Johnson.



Use one of the techniques you have been taught in our topic on light, line and shade, to draw a picture of an everyday object in your home. Try to be aware of the source of light in your picture so that you can create areas of light and shade.



A still life is a painting or drawing of an arrangement of objects, such as flowers, fruits and vegetables. Explore examples of still life artwork online. Collect and arrange a selection of seasonal produce, then create a still life drawing or painting of your arrangement. Think about including tints and shades of colour in your piece. Remember to give your completed artwork a title.



Year 5 - Line, Light and Shadow

Choose one or more of these challenges to complete this half term. You will need to submit your work during the week beginning Monday 25th March 2024,

You are also expected to complete regular reading, tables and spellings practice.

Research famous still life paintings and drawings. Choose your favourite and try to copy it as accurately as you can. Don't forget to write the name of the artists and a few details about the painting, such as when it was painted and what materials were used.



Learn about a flowering plant's life cycle and how they reproduce, including which plant parts are involved in reproduction, using information books and the internet. Record your findings as a scientific report using labelled diagrams and specific examples. Share your report with a family member.



Write a short mystery adventure story in the style of our class reader, 'The Nowhere Emporium.' Remember to consider characters, locations and plot before you start writing.



Draw a poster to promote a healthy lifestyle for children of your age. On the poster try to explain some of the benefits of a healthy lifestyle. Research the themes for your poster so that it can be informative and educational. It could promote topics such as healthier eating, getting more exercise and less screen time.
