

Maths

We will be starting the half term by looking at Decimals. This will involve us rounding decimals and multiplying and dividing decimals by whole numbers. We will be having a concentrated lesson per week on Arithmetic to help develop the children's arithmetic skills.



English

In our English lessons we will be starting off by looking a picture of a character and using that as inspiration to write a character description. We will then be looking at the short film 'Paperman' and using this to write a narrative. We will then be moving onto looking at Anne Frank's diary and Leo's diary from our visit to write our own diary entry.



RE



This half term we will be looking at Christianity by looking at the big question of 'What difference does the resurrection make for Christians?' We will be looking at why Christians believe in the resurrection, why they see Easter Sunday as a day of hope and think about how this impacts our own views.



Computing

This term we will be looking at the computing unit 'We are Advertisers' we will review existing adverts, create a storyboard and create our own adverts.



Year 6 Curriculum overview Spring 2 2024

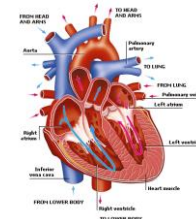


PE

PE for 6A will be on a Monday and Thursday, for 6B it will be on a Thursday and Friday and 6C it will be on a Tuesday and Thursday.

Science

We will be looking at the Circulatory System. We will be identifying and naming the main parts of the human circulatory system, describe the main parts of the heart and describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans. We will then look at the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood, we will consider the effect that diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle has on the way our bodies function.



Homework

Children are expected to read daily, complete weekly spellings and practise their times tables. In preparation for SATs we will provide the children with some SATs buster books, which weekly work will be set from. In addition this, the children will be given a homework flyer with a list of exciting activities linked to the topics covered. They can complete one activity before the end of the half term.



PSHE

We will be looking at 'Healthy Me.' We will look at how we can take responsibility for our health and well-being, we will then consider how different drugs effect our bodies. We will then look at how some people can be exploited and become members of gangs and the risks that this involves. We will then consider people's attitudes towards mental health / illness and look at the causes and triggers of stress.

History

We will be looking at Britain at War, we start by looking at causes of World War 2, how Britain prepared for the war. Followed by looking at and understanding the significance of the 'Battle of Britain.' We will evaluate the impact of war and the bias in historical sources. We will look at the human impact of war by looking at how the Jewish people were treated during the war; we will look at the life of Anne Frank and will finish by looking at how 'D-Day' and the 'Battle of the Bulge' led to the end of the war. We also have our visit by Bletchley Park and our visit to Leo's Journey.
