History

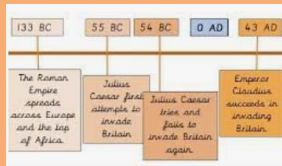
Draw a Roman Soldier then label their clothing and armour.

Where does it start and end?

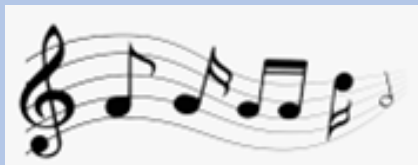
Find out about some of the places it goes through.
